

Reception Autumn 1 Home learning

Topic 'All about me!'

Which challenges will you choose to complete?

Who can you think of who helps us? What jobs do they do? When was the last time you visited the dentist, doctor, etc. What questions would you ask them about their job?

Talk about the rules we have at home and school. Why do we have those rules?
Why are they so important? Maybe you could think of some ideas for new rules!

Have a look in a recipe book and choose something to cook or bake. What ingredients do you need? See if you can follow the instructions to make your chosen creation.

As autumn begins, what changes can you see happening around you? Look at the trees, think about the weather and talk about the clothes you need to wear. Maybe you could draw an autumn picture.

Create a shopping list together for the next time you visit the supermarket. Can you have a go at using it, recognising some sounds and trying to find the correct object on the shelves.

Use a mirror to create a self-portrait. You could use paint, colouring pencils, junk modelling – whichever materials and tools you want to!

Explore the story

After reading it a few
times, see if you can
retell the story and
remember what
happens in order.

Have a look at some family photos and talk about the similarities and differences between your family members. Is your family exactly the same as other families? It's great to be different!

Grab some paper and practice using scissors. Can you cut on a straight line? A wavy line? A zigzag line?
