Where in the World Do I Live?

In Year 2, our new topic is 'Where in the World do I Live?' We will use our Geography skills to discover more about the four countries that make up the United Kingdom.

PSHCE: Citizenship - Rights, Rules and Responsibilities

Science: Animals Including Humans
In Science, we will investigate the different stages of life in animals and humans and find out about the basic needs of animals. We will then find out about the five food groups and learn about the importance of exercise.

Design and Technology

Geography: Where in the World?

Mathematics:

- Count forwards and backwards in steps of 2, 3, 5 and 10.
- Recognise the place value of each digit in a two-digit number (tens and ones).
- Compare and order numbers to 100.
- Read and write numbers to 100.
- Add and subtract numbers mentally.
- Solve a range of problems using these facts.
