
RE: Christianity: Symbols - What are the best symbols of Jesus' death and resurrection at Easter?

Computing: We will be learning how to code and debug simple programs.

History: We will become History detectives to find out clues about the origin of the Great Fire of London and the impact it had on the city. We will be using Drama to understand how people such as Samuel Pepys felt at the time.

English:

- We will read the model text 'Toby and the Great Fire of London', learn about writing diary texts and eventually write our own diary as if we were there at the time of the fire.
- We will read 'The Gruffalo', design our own monster and then write a character description based on our monster's personality and appearance.



PSHCE: Myself and My Relationships: We will find out about managing change.
