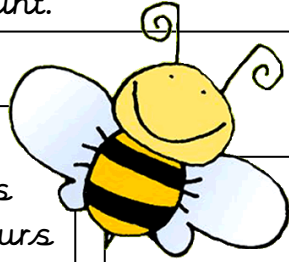


Year 3 Summer Term B

Le Petit Chaperon Rouge (Little Red Riding Hood).

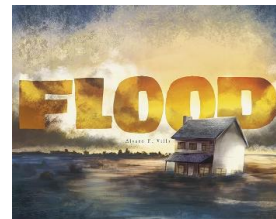


Science:

English:

In English, the children will be writing a narrative based upon 'The Flood' by Alvaro F. Villa.



RE:

How and why do people care for our world?

The children will consider this question from different religious and non-religious viewpoints and think about how we can look after the planet.

What's happening in our natural environment?

Children will spend the half term learning about some of the amazing plants that grow in different places around the world!

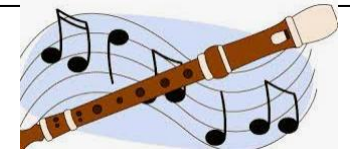
PE:

The children will be learning to use the skills to play tennis and outdoor adventurous activities with a focus on teamwork.

PSHE:

Managing Risk: Children will learn about the importance of having a healthy lifestyle.
