French:

Learning place vocabulary and directional skills relating to "en ville" (around town).

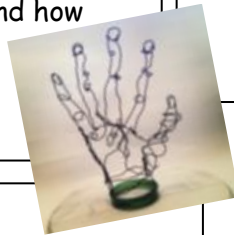


Computing:

We will be practising coding cross-curricularly with DT to program a Crumble Controller

Art:

We will look at sculpture and how this relates to form and shape. We will be able to create our own examples.



R.E:

We will look at Christianity and beliefs with discussions around how Christians show their belief that Jesus is God incarnate?

PSHE:

Health and Safer Lifestyles: The children will reflect on their understanding of keeping safe whilst cycling on the roads, playing in the sun, and around electricity.
A special PSHCE unit will focus on anti-bullying, and how they can be more aware of the role they play.

P.E:

Dance: Children will develop their understanding of movement through connecting motions and choreographed routines.

Hockey: Children will develop their understanding of key skills in hockey and apply them to games.



WW2

Children will continue to spend the half term learning about WW2 and the impact on Britain. The children will investigate the poignant events throughout the war and how life in Britain changed during and after the end of the war.

English:

Fiction: Alternative perspective writing based on Kensuke's Kingdom by Michael Morpurgo

Non-fiction: biography, based on one of the characters in our novel study of Kensuke's Kingdom

Poetry: Free Verse Poetry, emphasising function and sentence construction through our understanding of links between language and punctuation

Grammar: this term we will look at using relative clauses, relative pronouns, modal verbs, question tags, fronted adverbials and passive voice

We will use various tenses and understand when to use each in our writing to help establish the concept of time

Punctuation: semi colons, bullet points and pairs of dashes for parenthesis

We will also consider layout devices such as lines and verses



History:

Children will learn about the events of WW2. They will be taught about the allies and axis of power, Remembrance Day, Barbarossa and other important dates in WWII before placing these on a time line.

Maths:

- Reflecting on decimal numbers and how these can be rounded, ordered and compared
- Calculations with addition and subtraction along a number line, comparing values, column method and applying previously taught ideas
- Measure and classify angles and how they are calculated in shapes and along lines
- Understand and draw shapes and nets of 3D shapes
- Long and short multiplication and division

Science:

Electricity: Children will revise the scientific symbols for a circuit, how to make a circuit and conductivity of materials. They will then plan and carryout investigations linked to these ideas.

Music:

"Let's Swing!" Pupils will focus on swing music, a style that was popular throughout WWII, with a specific focus on the rhythms and melodies heard with this variety of music
