### Summer Term - Reception and KS1 Sports Club

In the Summer term, we would like to offer our Reception and KS1 children an opportunity to take part in a before school sports club. The club will be run by a coach from Mini Athletics and will take place on Monday, Wednesday and Thursday mornings. Mini Athletics pride themselves on teaching children through fun play! The sessions are built around what children love to do the most - running fast, jumping high and throwing far - and are mixed with imaginative weekly themes. The sessions will help your child to learn to follow instructions, make friends and develop athletics skills such as running and throwing whilst also having fun. Children can come to school wearing their PE kits on the days that the sessions take place.

The sessions, which last for 45 minutes, will run from 7:50am to 8:35am on Monday, Wednesday and Thursday mornings and will take place in the studio. The sessions will begin on **Monday 17<sup>th</sup> April** and will run until **Thursday 13<sup>th</sup> July**, resulting in a total of 12 sessions. At the end of the session, the children will be accompanied from the studio to their classroom. The cost of each session is £5.00, giving a total of £60 for all 12 sessions. We are sure that the Mini Athletics Sports club will be very popular so we are restricting the places to one session per week per child. Once you have decided on your selected day, this will be your day for the whole term.
